Children - Under 2 Years

FULL-TIME PLACE:

Monthly rate £1,187 per month - this works out at £274 per week
Payable monthly by direct debit.

PART-TIME PLACE:

Monthly rate £65 per day. Payable monthly by direct debit at the rate
of £65 per day including holidays

Emergency days £67 per day. Payable on the day.

AM/PM PLACES (limited availability)

Monthly Rate: £34.00 per AM session.
£32.00 per PM session. Payable monthly by direct debit.

Children - Over 2 Years

FULL-TIME PLACE:

Monthly rate £1,027 per month - this works out at £237 per week
Payable monthly by direct debit.

PART-TIME PLACE:

Monthly rate £57 per day. Payable in advance by direct debit at the rate of
£57 per day including holidays.

Emergency days £60 per day. Payable on the day.

AM/PM PLACES:

Monthly rate £31 per AM session
 £29 per PM session. Payable monthly by direct debit

DEPOSITS: Full-time place £500.00
 Part-time place £250.00

N.B. Only 1 deposit is required per family. Deposits are refundable on leaving the nursery, provided four weeks notice has been given in writing. If a child leaves the nursery or reduces his/her attendance four weeks notice in writing is required and if four weeks notice is not given a term's fees (or an appropriate proportion in the case of a reduction in attendance) will be payable. Fees are due four weeks before a place is taken up. Fees include Christmas and Easter closure and all Bank Holidays and are calculated on a 52 week basis. Fees are revised each year in January. Outings and some extra-curricular activities are extra and invoiced separately.

We are a registered "OFSTED" day nursery and do accept child-care and nursery vouchers.

As part of Bringing up Baby's ongoing commitment to working in partnership with Parents, we are proud to announce that we have been successful in our bid to join the Childcare Affordability Programme (CAP).

The purpose of this scheme is to offer flexible childcare at affordable rates to parents who need support in order to continue with their employment or wish to return to the workforce.
